Schedule

- Last semester of 12th grade, spanning 2 months; 4 days per week, from 9 AM to 4 PM.
- Cooperative Education Internship Skill Development Course: Return to school five times a week for work summaries, discussing encountered challenges, brainstorming solutions, and composing weekly internship reports.
